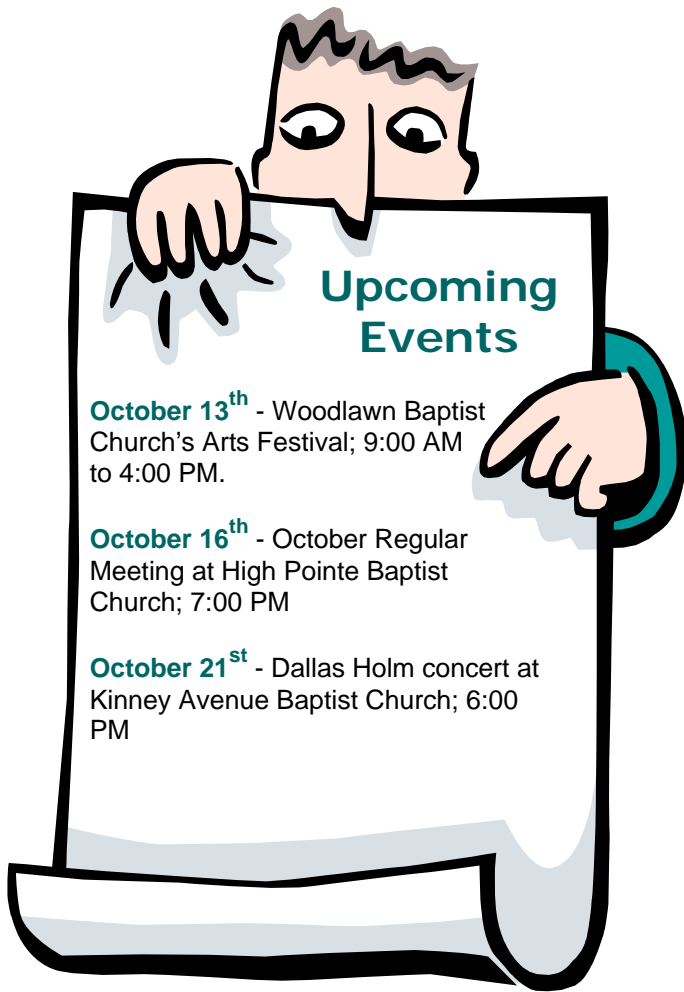
Purpose Statement

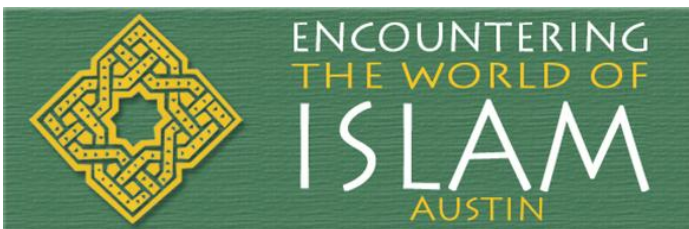
